




Eye Contact Board Game



Who Can Play?: 2+ players

What do you need?:

- Access to a printer
- Dice
- A counter for each player (you can use a coin, a button or a small toy)

Preparation:

- Print out the following pages
- Place pages 2 + 3 side by side and Sellotape to keep in place
- Cut out the cards on pages 4 + 5 and sort into three piles (one pile for each shape)
- Shuffle the cards in each pile

How to Play:

- Make sure each player is sitting at eye level
- Place all counters on the start box
- Take turns rolling a die and moving your counter along the board
- If you land on a shape, pick a card with that shape and follow the instructions
- If you land on an empty box, wait for the next turn
- The player who reaches the end box first is the winner
















For the next round, look at the person whose turn is next. Continue until everyone has a turn




